"Your Role in the Creation of God" is the article for this month. The information in the article takes you as far into the future as God's revelation of Scripture gives us understanding. Your role in creation began with the creation of Adam, your direct ancestor whose DNA had no imperfections. This was necessary so that thousands of generations would issue from Adam.

Even with sin, the children of Adam had tremendous vitality that allowed them to live several hundred years. That might be because their bodies regenerated from injuries, their minds and memories remained undimmed by age for reasons beyond our modern understanding. Yet because of gross sin, all but eight of Noah's family died in the flood. Re-population began.

God first created Adam. Then He made Eve from Adam's body, and they had many children (perhaps with several multiple births, Genesis 5:4). They in turn married and had children — until we come to YOU, the subject of this month's article. Now there are 7+ <u>billion</u> of Adam's offspring alive at this moment. All of Adam's offspring will become children of God whose bodies are prophesied to be "... sown in dishonor ... raised in glory; ... sown in weakness ... raised in power" (1 Corinthians 15:43, King James Version).

God created you to love. You should love God and Christ: "We love him, because he first loved us" (1 John 4:19). We all love ourselves. Loving oneself is not ego-driven; it is how God made you and every other human being. God commands that you love your neighbors <u>as yourself</u> (Matthew 19:19, 22:39; and several other verses). Dr. Martin established ASK in 1985 to have even greater independence to publish his research. He directed ASK until his death in January 2002. ASK continues to teach universal salvation whenever possible. It has been a strong belief of mine since 1976. We are grateful to publish articles about universal salvation as well as other historical, doctrinal, and prophetic biblical topics. May God bless you for providing the means for ASK to carry on Dr. Martin's work and give new insights into God's Word.
