Commentary for January 15, 2025 – Worldwide Chaos Postponed?

Yes, a political apocalypse has apparently been postponed. Society will not collapse with the United States dissolving into civil war. Soon after I publish this Commentary President Donald Trump will be inaugurated again as President of the United States on January 20, 2025. Pray that God will protect him before that event and during his presidency (1 Timothy 2:1–3).

However, if Donald Trump fails in his policies, if he is killed, or incapacitated to no longer serve as President, then the world may take a sudden turn to become one united world before the Antichrist appears on the world stage.

The End-Time Gospel Must Be Preached Before Christ's Return

The End-Time Gospel has not been preached to the world — yet. Starting from Jerusalem, Israelites will perform most of the teaching. Perhaps billions of people around the world will believe, and the majority of Israelites will accept Jesus Christ as their Messiah.

“And heralded shall be this evangel [Gospel] of the kingdom in the whole inhabited earth [Why?] for a TESTIMONY TO ALL THE NATIONS, and **THEN [and not before] the consummation [the end] shall be arriving.”**

• **Matthew 24:14 CLV**

Yes, this Gospel was preached in the 1st century AD, but Christ did not return then. It will be successful at the End Time, yet future to us. But many of the “conversions” will not endure.

Jesus spoke privately to His disciples, not to the people. Mark and Luke also wrote about this private message. Jesus did not speak in parables but plainly. Then He told them what would occur after the “**evangel of the kingdom**” was preached. A notable event will occur.

“Whenever, then, you may be perceiving the abomination of desolation, which is declared through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place [of a rebuilt Jewish Temple] **(let him who is reading apprehend!) ...”**

• **Matthew 24:15 CLV**

Jesus’s reference is to Daniel Chapter 9. (Read it for yourself.)

“... And, except those days were discounted [shortened], no flesh at all would be saved. Yet, because of the chosen, those days **shall be discounted.”**

• **Matthew 24:22 CLV**

A New “Golden Age” — Before the Antichrist

The result will be a new (and perhaps short) “Golden Age” of biblical information, to be recognized as “**the times of refreshing**” and “**the restoration of all things**” that Peter spoke about at Pentecost in the book of Acts:

“Repent, then, and turn about for the erasure of your sins, [Why?] so that seasons of refreshing should be coming from the face of the Lord, and He should dispatch

the One fixed upon before for you, Christ Jesus, Whom heaven must indeed receive UNTIL the times of restoration of all which God speaks through the mouth of His holy prophets who are from the eon."

• *Acts 3:19–21 CLV*

The King James Version reads as follows:

"Repent you therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And He shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began."

• *Acts 3:19–21 KJV*

Remember what happened at the Tower of Babel after the great flood:

"Then Yahweh descended to see the city and the tower that the sons of humanity had built. Yahweh said:

'Behold, they are ONE people with ONE language for all of them; and this is what they start to do. Now ANYTHING they plan to do will not be restricted for them. Grant attention! Do let us descend, and do let us disintegrate their language there, so that each man may not hearken to the language of his associate.'

Then Yahweh scattered them from there [to live] over the surface of the entire earth, and they left off building the city and the tower."

• *Genesis 11:5–8 CLV*

In history the city of Babel (later named Babylon) withered away. It must be rebuilt before Christ returns. See the 1925 article by F.E. Marsh: "[Will Babylon be Rebuilt?](#)" and Dr. Ernest Martin's 1975 article: "[The Rebirth of Babylon.](#)"

God did not cancel the human desire to do evil in a unified manner at that occasion in Babel. God merely **postponed** the fulfillment of humanity's desire — to become like God on their own, but without God. It sounds absurd, but YHWH was serious about this challenge. Read Romans chapter one to learn about the depravity of every person. Unknowingly, all are **already** saved through Christ. They will be told, and become future mature children of God.¹

God will allow most people of the world **"to unite under one language"** (Genesis 11:6). This may occur with the help of Artificial Intelligence ("AI"). They will have two goals: to oppose their creator and support the Antichrist. God will send a **"strong delusion"** upon mankind (2 Thessalonians 2:11). The Antichrist will declare himself to be God — YHWH Himself. Most of the world, except those who believe in the true God, will strongly unite under his rule.

The antichrist at this time likely will be possessed by Satan, supported by rebellious spirits and **"principalities and powers"** from the heavens above the earth, on the earth, and under the earth (Exodus 20:4; Philippians 2:10; Revelation 5:3, 13). Yes, some day we will remember what is, at this moment — our future.

¹ There will be two future "mass" rejections of God **[1]** when Christ returns and judges the world (Revelation 14:14–20), and **[2]** at the end of the 1,000-year reign of Christ (Revelation 20:7–10).
